Clause	Original Statement	Proposal of the Amendment
3.(3).(b)	if the committee approved the application, request the applicant to pay (within the period of 28 days after receipt by the applicant of the notification) the sum payable under this constitution by a member as entrance fee and annual subscription.	if the committee approved the application, request the applicant to pay (within the period of 14 days after receipt by the applicant of the notification) the sum payable under this constitution by a member as entrance fee and annual subscription.
4.(d)	fails to pay the annual membership fee under clause 8 (2) within 3 months after the fee is due.	fails to pay the annual membership fee under clause 8 (2) within 3 months 2 weeks/4 weeks after the fee is due without notification.
8.(1)	A member of the association must, on admission to membership, pay to the association a fee of \$80 or, if some other amount is determined by the committee, that other amount.	A member of the association must, on admission to membership, pay to the association a fee of \$10 or, if some other amount is determined by the committee, that other amount.
14.(2)	The total number of committee members is to be 9 , in which at least 1 committee member is to represent non-NSW members.	The total number of committee members is to be 7 , in which at least 1 committee member or standing member is to represent non-NSW members. And the president may decide the vacant committee members under clause 14.(1) and 14.(3)
14.(3).(e)	the membership officer.	(Removed)
14.(5)	There is no maximum number of consecutive terms for which a committee member may hold office.	The maximum number of consecutive terms for which a committee member may hold office is 4 years .
15.(a)	must be made in writing, signed by 2 members of the association and accompanied by the written consent of the candidate (which may be endorsed on the form of the nomination), and	must be made in writing, signed by 3 members of the association whose membership is over 3 months on the election date , and accompanied by the written consent of the candidate and declaration of interests (which may be endorsed on the form of the nomination), and
25.(2).(a)	within 6 months after the close of the association's financial year, or	within 2 months after the close of the association's financial year, or
26.(2).(c)	to elect office-bearers of the association and ordinary committee members,	to elect office-bearers of the association and ordinary committee members every 2 years ,
